South of France

With an up-front nose of citrus fruit, this is a grassy and herbaceous blend with invigorating elderflower hints.

San Giorgio Pinot Grigio **£22.00**
Italy

This is a crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate.

Kokako Sauvignon Blanc **£30.00**

Gooseberry, and tropical spectrum. Citrus backbone. Fresh acidity with more mid-palate.

Triplica Greco di Tufo DCG **£26.00**

This wine is perfumed, tropical and refreshing – expect hints of mango, pear and fresh herbs. Delicious with fresh mozzarella.

Ecclesia Vermentino di Sardegna **£28.00**
Italy
Vermentino is the gem of the island of Sardinia. Because it's still relatively unknown, you can find great value with the grape. Like this expression from Ecclesia. It's made by a family whose wines top tables in the best Italian restaurants. It's intense and aromatic, with notes of summer fruits. Excellent with seafood.

La Raia 'Il Borgo' Gavi **£32.00**
Italy
The flavours are bright and pure with citrus, and stone fruit to the fore enhanced by floral and mineral notes.

Sparkling & Champagne

Apericena Prosecco **£24.00**
Italy
175ml Glass **£6.95**
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.

Bel Canto Rosé **£24.00**
Italy
175ml Glass **£6.95**
An intense nose of a floral bouquet of roses and violets, with a light yeasty note. Fresh and full, with strawberry and raspberry notes on the palate.

Nicolas Courtin Brut NV **£40.00**
Champagne
175ml Glass **£10.50**
Each and every detail of Nicolas Courtin is attentively observed to ensure that what reaches your flute is pure, elegant Champagne. It's rich and smooth, white notes of toast, citrus and apple and a delicate mousse.

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV **£70.00**
Champagne
Founded by Madame Clicquot in 1772, Veuve Clicquot, the house that once entertained Napoleonic soldiers, is known as the 'Queen of Champagnes'. Aged for twice as long as is legally required and made from grapes plucked from the finest vineyards, it's as biscuity rich as they come.

Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV **£90.00**
Champagne
Unusually made by the saignee method, with plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm. A wonderfully refreshing aperitif, it also works well with a variety of dishes.

Dom Perignon, Gift Box **£195.00**
Champagne
Exceptional depth, rich texture and great ageing potential characterises this iconic Champagne from Moët et Chandon, named after the Benedictine monk who pioneered Champagne.

RED Wine

South of France

Soft, ripe and jammy blackcurrant fruit alongside a muscular texture makes this a robust, well balanced wine.

Crescendo Merlot **£19.50**
Italy

Intense ruby red in colour with typical scents of red fruit and tomato leaf. On the palate, well defined notes of red berries confirm the profile found by the nose, with a round and complete finish.

Brooding, deep, intense aromas of Christmas cake, chocolate, cinnamon, sweet fruits and spice. The concentrated palate offers a thick texture and soft velvety tannins, very rich fruit characteristics.

Amarone Classico Costasera, Masi **£60.00**
Italy
Prune, fig and chocolate are to name but a few. Every sip discovers another beautiful flavour from this brilliant producer.

Rosé Wine

Pinot Grigio Rosé Le Colline di San Giorgio **£22.00**
Italy

Fresh apricot and peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish.

Crescendo White Zinfandel Rosé **£23.50**

With an elegant colour, this wine is fresh, with aromas that become more complex with time. Due to the balance between soft tannins, acidity and residual sugar this wine has a very interesting structure.

Whispering Angel is the most popular Provence rosé in America. This fresh vintage has elegant hints of peach, rose water and summer berries and a strawberry-scented finish.
